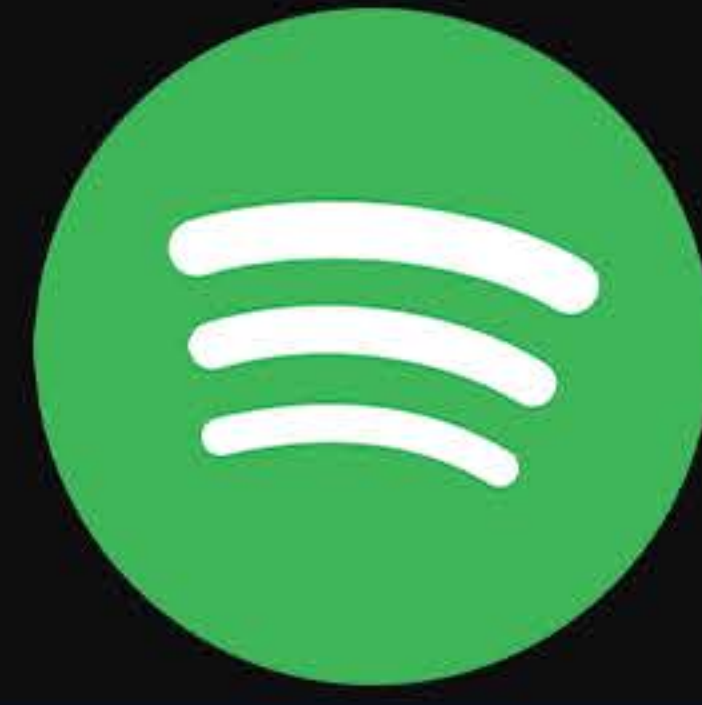

Brad Hudson began singing and playing music at the early age of three. The first instrument Brad learned to play was guitar, a gift from his parents on his sixth birthday. Soon he began to experiment with banjo and dobro. He also learned how to read the Nashville number system, a huge asset to him in his career. Brad has toured with Dollywood stars The Larkin's as their bassist. They opened up for Eric Church, Collin Raye and even Dolly Parton. Later Brad was offered a job with award winning bluegrass band Carolina Road. Brad moved on to explore more opportunities and began singing and playing at the Country Tonite Theatre in Pigeon Forge, TN. He quickly became well known for his superb tenor and string skills. In September of 2014, he was given the opportunity to tour with Gospel greats, Gaither TV stars and Grammy nominated artists, Jeff & Sheri Easter as their drummer. Eventually, Brad was invited to join the great Country Grass project with Lorraine Jordan & Carolina Road. Brad sang a duet on the album with John Conlee on John's big number one hit from the 80's "Common Man." Soon after, he was contacted by Dollywood about being part of a show called "My People". Brad formed his own band in 2017 and signed a record deal with Pinycastle Records. The Brad Hudson Band plays around the Southeast at prestigious venues like Blakes Shelton's Ole Red. They continue to release new music during 2021 including singles 'Two Dozen Roses' and 'Someone Else Is Loving Her Now.'
